November - December

- Heritage application period opens
- Scholarship research – find scholarship opportunities on washboard.org
- Contact Heritage University for scholarship details

January

- Complete your FAFSA application (fafsa.ed.gov)
- Do not delay filing because you or your parents have not filed your taxes; use last year's tax return or estimate

March

- Contact Financial Aid Office and ask if your FAFSA has been received
- Ask if you were selected for verification
- If you were selected, submit necessary items as soon as possible
- Registration opens March 31st

April

- Return award letters and complete online counseling requirements

May

- Meet with Financial Aid Office or assigned financial aid coordinator to answer any other questions

August

- Get prepared for school to start
- Attend our new student orientation
